Head Coaches:

- Up to the head coach how many players you bring. (Usually around 25)
- ***Winning Team will be presented with the "Larry Sellitto Memorial 7 on 7" Plaque ***
- Head coaches must remain with their teams throughout the day. If the head coach is unable to attend the 7 on 7, please designate an interim HC.

Equipment:

- Helmet and mouthpiece
- Teams should wear the same color t shirt / jersey
- Bring a 2nd color (if possible)
- Teams are recommended to bring a center

Field / Time / Starting the Game:

- 40 yard field / 10 yard end / 20 yard line will be a first down
- 25 minute game (Game will end at 25 minutes / NO Over Time)
- A coin flip will determine who gets the ball 1st

Scoring:

- 6 points for a TD
- 1 point for a PAT from the 3 yard line (no points for an interception on a PAT)
- 2 points for a PAT from the 10 yard line (no points for an interception on a PAT)
- 1 point for a defensive stop on downs
- 3 points for an Interception (cannot return an interception for a TD)

The Tournament / Tiebreaker / Coaching:

- Winner of each bracket will be in the championship game
- Tiebreaker: Head to head is the 1st tiebreaker; total points scored minus the total points given up will be the 2nd tiebreaker, and last will be a coin flip.
- Only the championship game will continue if the game is tied at the end of 25 minutes. Teams will continue to play until someone scores.
- Coaches must stay behind the offense or on the sideline. Do not stand behind the defense.
- Each team will have 40 seconds to snap the ball after the ball has been blown dead from the previous play.
- Offensive team is responsible for retrieving and returning the ball to the previous spot or the new scrimmage spot in a timely fashion. Failure to do so can result in

Rules for the Offense:

- Offensive plays must be forward passes.
- Once a forward pass has been thrown, a lateral is allowed.
- Possession begins at the 40 yard line / 20 yard line will be a 1st down.
 - A team has 4 downs to get a first down.
 - The QB is allowed 4.0 seconds to throw the ball. The Official timekeeper will start on the snap of the ball from center and stops as soon as the QB releases the ball.
- Ball carrier is legally down when touched with one or both hands.
- Fumbles are dead balls at the spot with the last team retaining possession. A muffed snap is not a fumble/dead ball. The 4.0 second count still remains in effect.

Penalties for the Offense: (All 5 yard penalties)

- Pass interference – 5 yards from the LOS & loss of down
- Blocking or Holding – 5 yards from the LOS & loss of down
- Delay of game – 5 yards from the LOS & loss of down
- Illegal motion or false start – 5 yards from the LOS / replay the down
- No penalty will be assessed in excess of the 40 yard line.
 - On an unsuccessful or successful offensive play from the 40 yard line resulting in an offensive penalty: The ball will be returned to the 40 yard line and 1st down will become 2nd down, 2nd down will become 3rd down, etc.

Rules for the Defense:

- Interception: is a dead ball on the catch. Cannot return for a TD
- Responsibility to avoid contact is with the defense. There will be NO grabbing or holding at the LOS. These actions will result in a "holding penalty".
- Defense can only drop 7 players into coverage. If you play 8 people on defense, one player must take a knee before the ball is snapped. The 8th player cannot stand or be involved in the play.

Penalties for the Defense: (All 5 yard penalties)

- Holding – 5 yards from the LOS / replay the down
- Pass interference – 5 yard penalty / replay the down
- Off sides – 5 yards from the LOS / replay the down
- 8 Players on defense – 5 yards from the LOS / replay the down

Special Rules or Penalties:

delay of game penalty.
 Offense must have 1 eligible receiver within the TE / Tackle box when the ball is snapped. If you start in an empty set, you must motion or shift a player in the backfield before the ball is snapped.

- 15 Yard Penalties – Unsportsman like conduct penalties
- o Unnecessary physical behavior, taunting, or trash talking
